

<u>Day 1</u>: This morning, our journey takes us into our nation's Capitol, **Washington**, **D.C.!** In 1862, the Washington D.C. Proclamation Act was passed, and for the first time in the country, slaves were free. Our first stop along the tour is **Arlington National Cemetery.** Have a chance to see the changing of the guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. There will be stops at the President John F. Kennedy gravesite, U.S. Coast Guard Memorial, U.S. Army Gen. John J. Pershing's gravesite, and the Arlington House (The Robert E. Lee Memorial) just to name a few. From here, we check into the **Holiday Inn Capitol**, for the next two nights, which is located right in the heart of the Capitol District, and within walking distance to the Smithsonian Museums, Restaurants, and so much more.

<u>Day 2:</u> A full breakfast is included this morning followed by a guided tour of Washington, D.C.'s African American Heritage Trail. Our guide will show us the African American Civil War Memorial, the Mary MacLeod home, the Lincoln Emancipation Statue, MLK Library, Howard University and more! By 1900, Washington had the largest percentage of African Americans of any city in the nation. Many came because of job opportunities and educational institutions. Howard University, founded in 1867, was a magnet for professors and students and would become the "capstone of Negro education" by 1930. African Americans also created hundreds of black-owned businesses and numerous business districts. **Dinner** this evening will be at **Tony & Joe's Restaurant**, located right on the waterfront. (B,D)

<u>Day 3</u>: After **breakfast**, we head over to the **National Museum of African American History and Culture** where we have timed entry tickets. There will be time for lunch, on own, before heading home. Evening return is planned. (B)


